

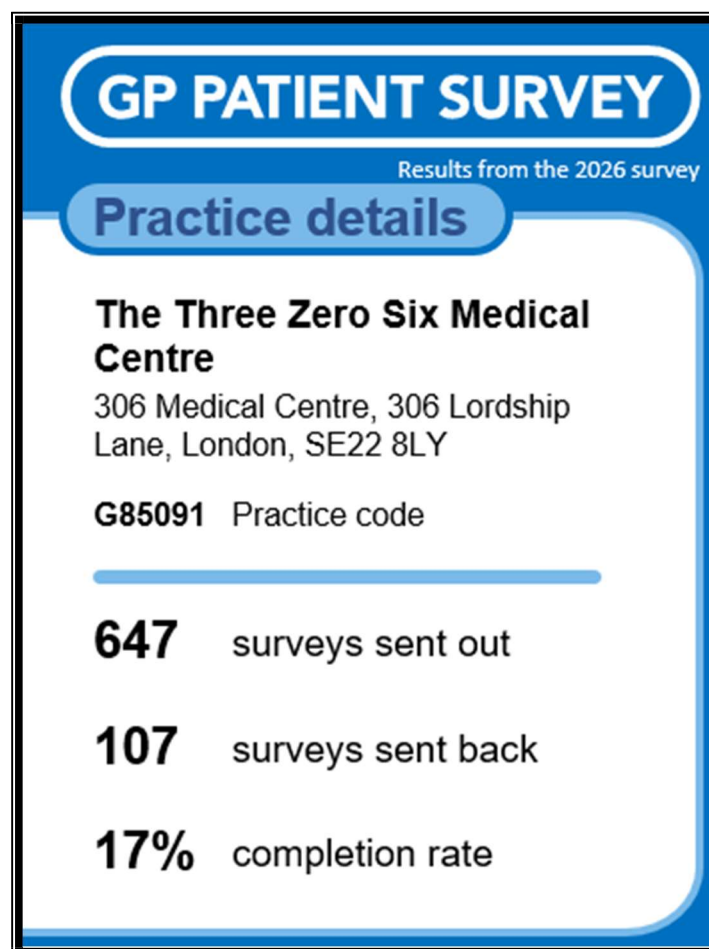

Results from the 2026 survey

What you thought of your practice, 306 Medical Centre!

The GP Patient Survey is an annual NHS England survey that asks patients about their experience of GP services. Results are based on a sample of patients and provide a snapshot of patient experience between January and April 2026. Because the survey is based on a sample, small differences between practices or national averages may not be statistically significant



The data provide a snapshot of patient experience at a given time and are updated annually.

Also, comparisons to the local (ICS) or national average may not be statistically significant and are indicative only. The sample size at practice level is statistically small.

Survey Highlights

- Overall patient experience remains very positive.
- Most results compare favourably with local and national averages.
- Appointment access remains the main area for continued improvement.
- The practice will continue reviewing demand, capacity and patient feedback.

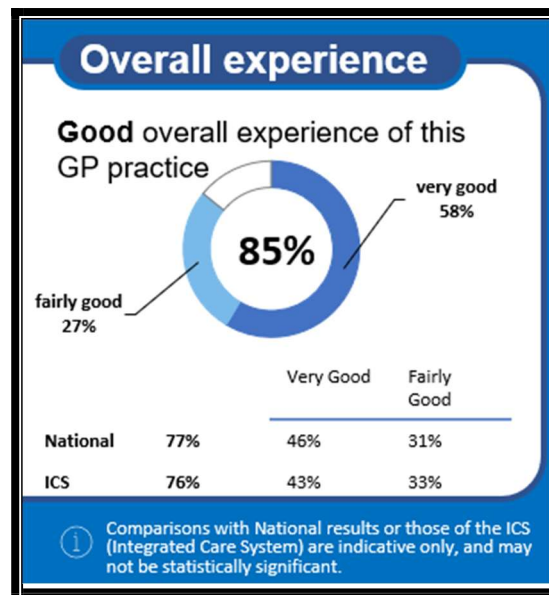

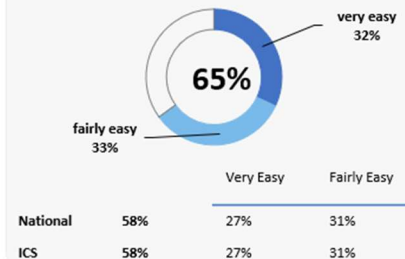
Good overall experience of contacting this GP practice



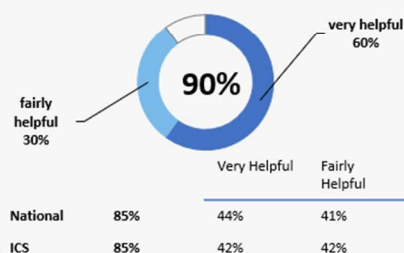
Easy to contact this GP practice on the phone



Easy to contact this GP practice using their website



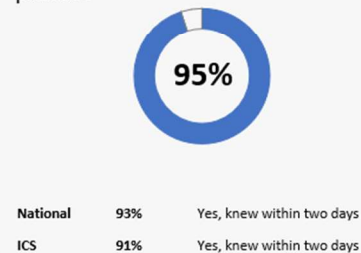
Helpfulness of reception and administrative team at this practice

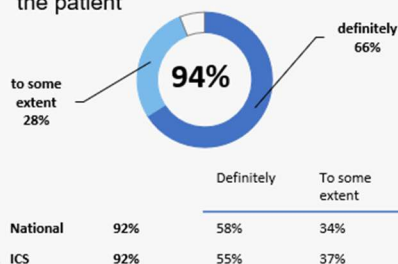

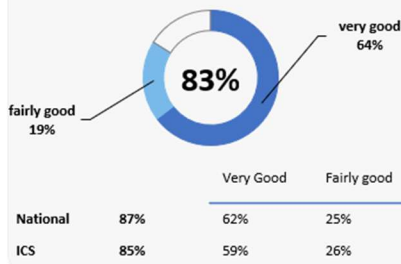

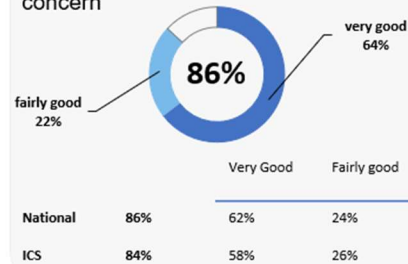
The healthcare professional had all the information they needed about the patient



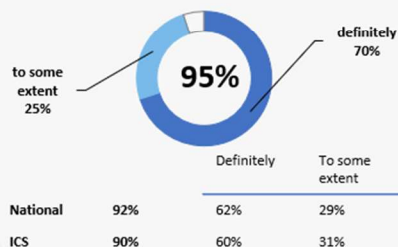
The healthcare professional was good at listening to the patient



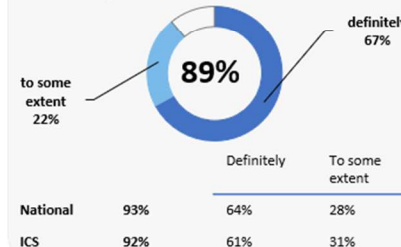
The healthcare professional was good at treating the patient with care and concern



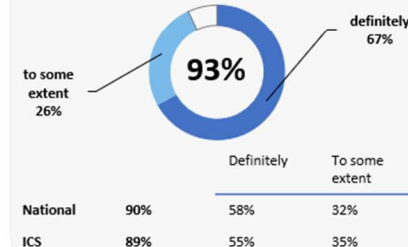

What this practice does best



Overall, patients rated the practice highly across most areas of the survey, reflecting continued positive experiences of access, care and support. Although response numbers remain relatively small, the results indicate consistently strong patient satisfaction.

This is very encouraging as it gives recognition to the practice's continued efforts in ensuring patients have a good experience.

Statistically the variations are small, and the outcomes likely impacted by the low response rate (fell by 2% in the previous year). However, they give a good snapshot of patient experience.

The results generally reflect good outcomes at challenging times for the NHS in general, when amongst many issues, we are experiencing unprecedented demands on our services and rising expectations.

ICS result: 92% | National result: 93%



83% of respondents say the healthcare professional they saw or spoke to was good at listening to them during their last general practice appointment

ICS result: 85% | National result: 87%

**The practice operates from a single site; however, patients can choose between telephone and face-to-face appointments where clinically appropriate.*

Comparisons with the local ICS or national results are indicative only and may not be statistically significant.

Areas for improvement

- Continue reviewing appointment availability.
- Monitor patient access and demand.
- Continue discussing survey findings with the Patient Participation Group.
- Review future survey results to measure progress.

SURVEY RESULTS - ACTIONS



Overall, the practice performance was very good and compared very well with local averages. Whilst the comparisons may not be statistically significant, the results give a good snapshot of patient experience.

- The survey results shared with the practice team and planned for discussion at a practice team meeting and at the next Patient Participation Group Meeting on 10 Sept 2026.
- The practice always strives to improve where practicable. The results show that our responsive approach has been consistently effective, and we will keep making efforts to improve in areas where we can make further improvements.
- We are also aware of the challenges of unprecedented demand for appointments. However, we will keep trying to pragmatically find a way to best meet the needs of our practice population in this area, by regularly reviewing demand and capacity.
- The practice acknowledges that the availability of timely appointments is important to patients and will continue to regularly review patient access and choice where practicable.
